As a multipurpose cooperative, HPPEMC offers various financial and non-financial products and services within and outside of the Cooperative such as savings and loans, catering services, office supplies, corporate giveaways, residential and office renovation, construction, and others.



What is a Cooperative?

A cooperative is similar to a corporation. But instead of being registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission, cooperatives are registered with the Cooperative Development Authority of the Philippines. For all intents and purposes, a cooperative is a business enterprise. But a business enterprise that is owned and operated directly by its members.
